1. "Wh" Question

To know how to ask and answer "Wh" questions, it is important to master first "Wh" words:

a-"wh" words

What: quel, quelle

Which: lequel, laquelle

Who: qui

Why : pourquoi When : Quand

Where : où

Whose: à qui (il n'a pas la même structure pour les questions)

How: comment

b- structure of "Wh" Questions

Example 1: Why do you like English?

1 2 3 4 5

Structure: "Wh" word + Auxiliary + subject + verb + object?

Example 2: Where do you come from?

1 2 3 4

Structure: "Wh" + Auxiliary + subject + verb?

Example 3: Where were you born?

1 2 3 4

<u>Structure</u>: "Wh" + Aux + Subject + verb?

c- Answers

To answer such Questions, we have to give precise and exact answer For example.

In the <u>example 1</u>: The Question is about the reason.

Example 2: the question is about the place.

Example 3: the question is also about the place

2. "Yes" or "no" Questions".

They have a bit the same structure.

a- Structure

Example 1: Do you like English?

<u>Structure</u>: Auxiliary + subject + verb + object?

Example 2: Are you a student

Structure: Auxiliary + subject + object?

b- Answers

To such questions, we have to answer by "yes" or "no" followed by the auxiliary.

Example 1: A : Do you like English?

B: yes, I do

Example 2: A: Are you a student?

B: No, I am not, I am a teacher.
